

Overview of quays at STANDiC Antwerpen

For navigation and/or customs purposes the quay number for Standic Antwerpen is 319-321 for quay 1 and 315-319 for quay 2. For quay 3, which is not yet available, the quay number is 313-315.

At this moment quays 1 and 2 are available for discharge and loading of vessels/barges. There will be three quays available at STANDiC Antwerp for discharge and loading of vessels/barges. Location of tanks and occupation of quays can influence the type of quays used.

Sea going vessels must always moor to starboard side. For vessels with a draft greater than 13 meters, it is mandatory to use a PPU pilot (Portable pilot unit). Above stated drafts are general figures expected after completion of the quay works. Please contact the Antwerp Port authorities for exact and up-to-date draft restrictions. Please be advised that there are no fenders available at our jetty, and they must be provided by the vessel.
